Nephro olockag of a sm	MARY OF THE EXAM rostomy tube insertion is a procedure used to provide urinary drainage due to age or obstruction in your kidney or urinary tract. The procedure involves the mall tube through your back that is guided into your kidney. This allows urine your kidney into a collecting bag.	insertion
WHAT TO EXPECT The procedure will be performed by a specially trained doctor called a radiologist. The radiologist will use X-ray to determine the best location to insert the tube. Your skin will be cleaned, and an antiseptic will be applied. A local anesthetic will be used to numb the area. The radiologist will then insert the tube into your back and guide it to your kidney. Once blaced, the tube is attached to a bag to collect urine.

NOTE: Blood work should always be drawn before X-rays are performed. If you are having blood work, please arrive early and inform the outpatient lab you have a radiology appointment. Please arrive on time for your radiology exam.

LENGTH OF EXAM

Please plan to be at the hospital for approximately three to four hours.

AFTER THE EXAM

You should expect to receive the results of your exam at your next health care provider appointment (if scheduled) or within 10 days of your exam. Please call your health care provider if you do not receive your results.

HOSPITAL PARKING
