NOTE: Blood work should always be drawn before X-rays are performed. If you are having blood work in addition to your biopsy, please arrive one hour early and inform the outpatient lab you have a radiology appointment. Please arrive on time for your radiology exam.

LENGTH OF PROCEDURE:

Please plan to be at the hospital for *about two hours* for this procedure.

AFTER THE PROCEDURE

The area will be cleaned, and a bandage will be placed on the biopsy site. You may apply ice to relieve any bruising or swelling. You will need to keep the biopsy site dry, and you may be asked to avoid heavy lifting for the first 24 hours after the biopsy. If you experience discomfort, do not take aspirin; you may take two Tylenol tables every four – six hours.

You should expect to receive the results of your exam at your next health care provider appointment (if scheduled) or within 10 days of your exam. Please call your health care provider if you do not receive your results.

HOSPITAL PARKING

Deck parking is available on 7th Street for a fee based on your length of stay.

DIRECTIONS TO THE DEPARTMENT

The Breast Care Center is located on the main level of Aultman Hospital between the main building and the Bedford Building.

- Bedford entrance: You will proceed up the stairs or elevators to the main level, and then you will turn to your left and go past Seasons Café. The Breast Care Center will be directly in front of you.
- 7th Street entrance: Walk through the lobby. Once you pass the main elevators, turn to your right and go past "The Shoppes at Aultman." The Breast Care Center will be to the right.
