## WHAT TO EXPECT

When you arrive for your procedure, you will be taken to the Radiology receiving area, where you will be asked to put on a gown, have your vital signs taken. Depending on the procedure being performed, an IV may be started.

☐ You will be required to read and sign exam consent forms. If reading glasses are

needed, please bring them with you.

You will then be taken to the ultrasound department, where a sonographer will explain the procedure to you, answer any questions you have and have you sign consent forms for the procedure.

You will be placed on a cart in a position that will allow the radiologist to access the area of interest in the safest way. You may be lying on your back, stomach or side. The radiologist will talk to you to make sure your questions have been answered, and the sonographer will scan the appropriate area using a transducer. Ultrasound works by bouncing sound waves off tissues, and there is no radiation exposure.

The radiologist will use the ultrasound images to determine the best spot to place the needle. Your skin will be cleaned with an antibacterial soap, then a local anesthetic will be used to numb the area.

#### WHAT TO EXPECT AFTER THE PROCEDURE

You will be taken back to the Radiology receiving area, where you will be monitored by our nursing staff. Your vital signs will be taken, and the nurses will address your medical needs. Once you are discharged to go home, you will need to rest and limit your activity for the rest of the day.

#### LENGTH OF EXAM

Plan on being in the department for *at least three hours*. Your discharge depends on how you feel after the procedure and the radiologist post procedure protocol.

### SCHEDULING AND REGISTRATION

Pre-registration is required for an accurate medical record and proper billing. You may be contacted by a patient access representative if we need any information. If you have questions or need to schedule or reschedule your exam, please call the Ultrasound Department at 330-363-6205. All exams require a written order from your physician.

#### **HOSPITAL PARKING**

Free visitor parking is available in Lot 3 across from the Bedford Building. Enter from 6<sup>th</sup> Street. Valet parking is available at the 7<sup>th</sup> Street and Bedford Building entrances for a fee – or free if you are a handicapped motorist. ## **DIRECTIONS TO THE DEPARTMENT**

Imaging Services/Radiology (7th Street deck parking is the closest parking) is located on the ground level of the main hospital. From the main hospital lobby, take the elevators to the ground level. After exiting the elevator, turn to your left and you will see the check-in desk.
